#### Questions From John 18

Why did Jesus make Himself so easy to arrest? (1-5,11) How did Jesus approach *fulfillment* in 8-9? How are Matthew's and John's account of Peter's denial different? (27 [Mt 26:75) Note the abnormalities/illegalities of Jesus's arrest and trial. (2,13,24,28-30, 38,etc.) What was significant about taking Jesus to Pilate? (31-32) Is it significant that 18:36-37 is the first time John

records Jesus acknowledging He is king?
